PRESIDENT'S WORK PROGRAMME 2024-2027 **HIGHLIGHTS**

Demanding that administrations provide services that are genuinely 'at the service of their affiliates', taking into account the population of pensioners, both in terms of its specific characteristics and its quantitative size (over 30,000 people).

In addition to the digital divide, which is widening due to the constant changes in IT communication tools, isolating a growing number of pensioners, this also requires listening and empathy on the part of the Administration.

- Take an active part in the work of the **CGAM**.
- Make effective progress towards recognition of JSIS by national health systems.
- Closely monitor the development of the **method**.
- Pursue cooperation between the **sections** and the International and between **sections**, in particular by actively pursuing meetings between treasurers and between those in charge of communication, social volunteers, insurance, etc. in the national sections.
- To ensure that the Association's **resources** match its expenditure, by exploring the possibility of increasing the subsidies paid.
- Finalising the overhaul of the **Statutes**.
- Communicate more effectively with our members, either directly or via the sections.
