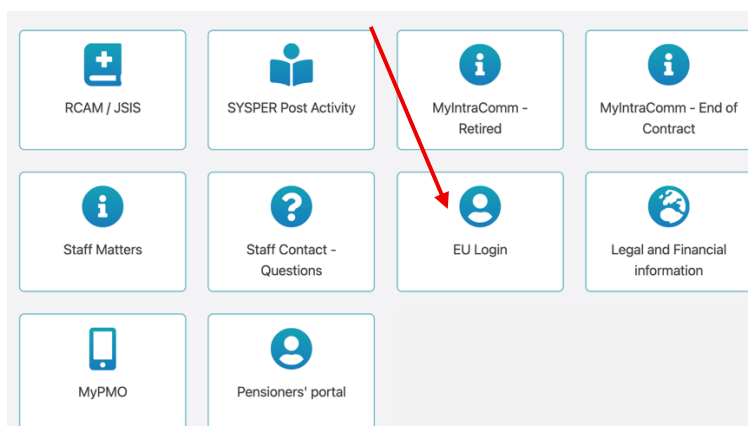


ADD eID TO YOUR EU LOGIN ACCOUNT

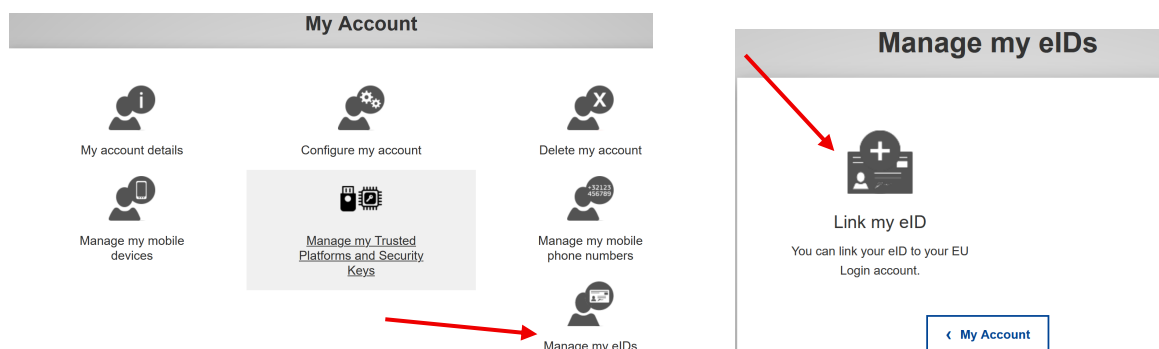
This guide will only work for you if you already have a well-functioning EU Login (relying on a verification method other than SMS) but want to also be able to log in with your eID.

If you did not already activate an alternative method to the SMS verification, please refer to our special guide for migration after 1 July 2025.

1. Launch <https://myremote.ec.europa.eu/>. Enter your email address and EU Login password on request. Update your EU Login password if required (*if you forgot it, click on [Lost your password?](#) to reset it. It must contain **at least 10 characters**, including lower- and upper-case letters, numbers and special characters (-, ?, &, % ...).* **Tip:** start it with the current **year and month**, followed by your preferred (permanent) password, such as **25-08Ukraine** (if created in August 2025).
2. Next, check that your **verification method** is set at a method you activated previously (**not SMS or Password!**). Click on it and then click "**Sign in**".
3. After authenticating using your existing method, you will now see the Welcome Screen of MyRemote. Click on the "**EU Login**" option.



4. Now click on "**Manage my eID**" and next, on "**Link my eID**"



5. You will now see a screen with a lot of flags. If your country is listed, select that and then click **Submit**.

eID Authentication

eID authentication is provided in accordance with the [eIDAS regulation](#) for all notified eID schemes. Additional eID schemes are supported on a voluntary basis.

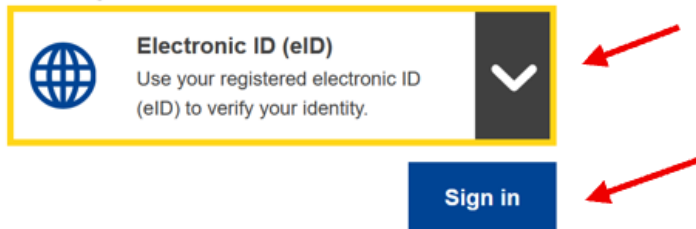
Now authenticate as you usually do with your national eID.

At the end of the procedure, the EU institutions will ask you to confirm your personal data. Confirm, and you will then receive a message that your eID was successfully linked to your EU Login account.

Now log out.

6. You can now use your eID as a verification method for your EU Login account. When logging in, remember always to check that the verification method is set at **Electronic ID** as shown below. If required, click on the arrow in the black box to select the correct verification method before signing in:
