

ADD eID TO YOUR EU LOGIN ACCOUNT

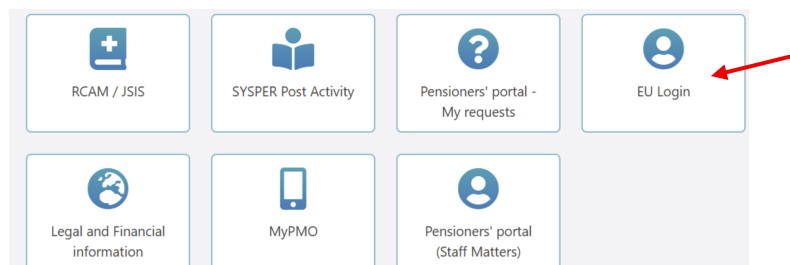
This guide is **only for pensioners who already have an EU Login account and a verification method which works, but who want to have alternative solutions available.**

If you do not yet have an EU Login account, please refer to our special guide for the creation of an EU Login account <https://aiace-europa.eu/tools/eu-login-app/>.

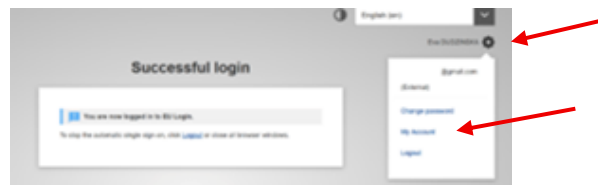
1. FIRST STEPS: Launch <https://myremote.ec.europa.eu/> from your browser. Enter your email address and EU Login password on request. Update your EU Login password if required (*if you forgot it, click on [Lost your password?](#) to reset it. It must contain **at least 10 characters**, including lower- and upper-case letters, numbers and special characters (-, ?, &, % ...).* **Tip:** start it with the current **year and month**, followed by your preferred (permanent) password, such as **Apr26-Ukraine** (if created in April 2026).

2. Next, check that your **verification method** is set at a method you have used successfully until now. If required, click on the arrow in the black box to open the drop-down menu. Click on it and then on **"Sign in"**.

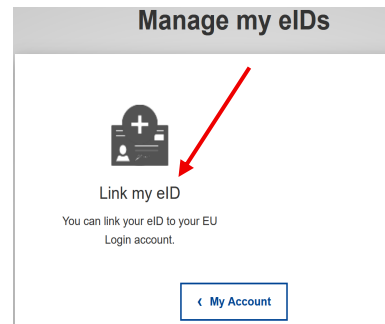
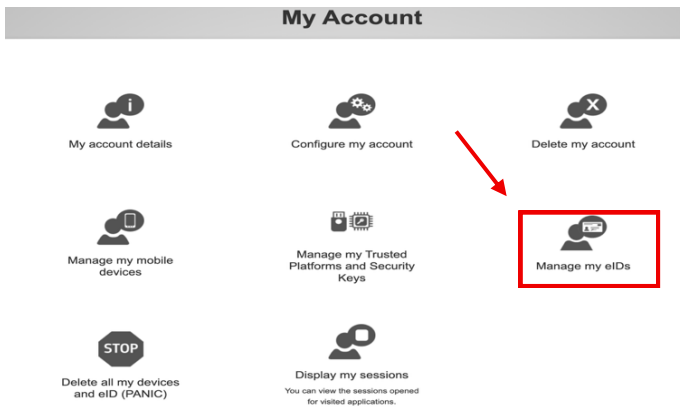
3. After authenticating using your existing verification method, you will now see the Welcome Screen of MyRemote. Click on the **"EU Login"** option.



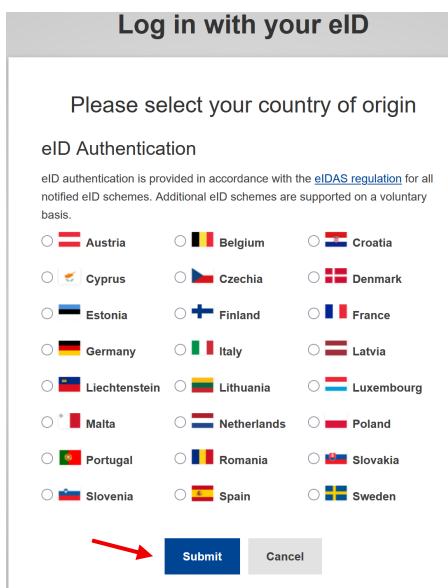
4. If you now see the screen below, click on the cog wheel top right next to your name and select **"My account"** from the drop-down menu. If not, go straight to point 5.



5. You are now in **"My account"**. Click on **"Manage my eID"** and next, on **"Link my eID"** :



6. You will now see a screen with a lot of flags. Click on your country and then **Submit**.

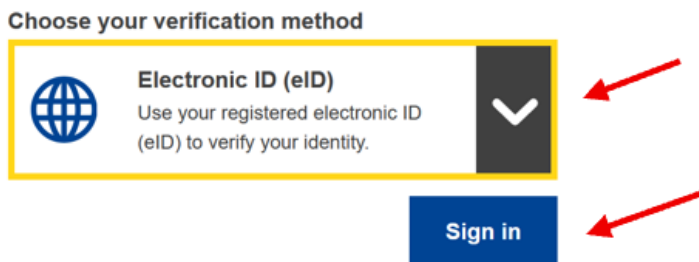


Now authenticate as you usually do with your national eID.

At the end of the procedure, the EU institutions will ask you to confirm your personal data. Confirm, and you will then receive a message that your eID was successfully linked to your EU Login account.

Now log out.

USE WITH EU LOGIN: You can now use your eID as a verification method for your EU Login account. Whenever you wish to use this verification method when logging on, remember always to check that the verification method is set at **Electronic ID** as shown below. If required, click on the arrow in the black box to select the correct verification method before signing in:



Next, follow the procedure in point 6, and you are in!
